Re: Application Acknowledgement for Camp Airstrip and Right of Way Project Proposal

Dear Mr. Nicholson:

On January 11, 2007 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received a Starfield Resources project proposal from the Kivalliq Inuit Association which includes the following project activities:

- Construction of 1380m × 30m airstrip runway
- Construction of 1.5km × 6m all-weather access road
- Movement of bulk fuel storage
- Winter trail right-of-way from Churchill, MB and Rankin Inlet, NU to Ferguson Lake

Starfield Resources has requested an amendment to Kivalliq Inuit Association Land Use License KVCL305H27 to include the airstrip and associated activities, and also has submitted a new application for a right-of-way to support the camp and construction of the airstrip. However, NIRB has determined that these project activities were **not** included in the camp and exploration project proposal (NIRB No. 06EN008) previously screened by NIRB and given a 12.4.4 (a) decision on March 27, 2006. Be advised that section 12.4.3 (a) of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement states:

Any application for a component or activity of a project proposal that has been permitted to proceed in accordance with these provisions shall be exempt from the requirement for screening by NIRB unless:

(a) such component or activity was not part of the original project proposal...

Therefore, pursuant to Part 4, Article 12 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), NIRB shall proceed to screen the project proposal, as defined by the activities outlined in first paragraph. You should also note that, NIRB reserves the right to request additional information at any time during the process. NIRB will copy you on screening process related correspondence and upload related documents to the above ftp site for Public access.

NIRB is copying interested Parties and municipalities most affected by Starfield Resources project proposal with this letter, and we invite interested persons to comment directly to the NIRB by February 1, 2007.
