Please find enclosed an updated Spill Plan for Starfield Resources Ferguson Lake Project and its various work sites in both hardcopy and electronic format. This Spill Plan replaces the Spill Plan that was originally submitted in February, 2005. Also included is an electronic copy of the Diamond Drill Plan Map showing the outline of this years Diamond Drilling Program. The enclosed Spill Plan is different from that recently submitted by RESCAN on Starfield's behalf.
