On January 7, 2013 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received Canada Coal Inc.'s (Canada Coal) "Fosheim Peninsula-Coal Exploration" project proposal from Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC). On January 7, 2013 the NIRB received a positive conformity determination (North Baffin Regional Land Use Plan) from the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) for this file. - Revised non-technical Project Proposal Summary in English and Inuktitut which includes the following:
  - The project activities, their necessity and duration;
  - *Method of transportation;*
  - Any structures that will be erected (permanent/temporary);
  - Alternatives considered; and
  - Long-term developments, the projected outcome of the development for the area and its timeline.
- Maps of the proposed activities including proximity of project to fossil plant materials (i.e. fossil forest); and
- Certificate of Incorporation of Pacific Coal Corp. (discussion of how Pacific Coal Corp. is related to the current application for development).
