As stated in the 2008 Annual Plan, in the summer of 2008 three persons were in a dome tent camp for six days prospecting on the property. One float-equipped fixed wing flight placed the team and removed them at the end of the project. No wildlife was encountered. No inspection was carried out. At the end of the program the latrine pit was backfilled and treated with lime and the greywater sump was backfilled. The land was returned to its original contours. No fuel was stored on site and all garbage was backhauled to the Nanaimo dump for disposal.
