**Cancellation of the Licence** 

## Dear Mr. Hanslit:

The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") has completed a preliminary technical review of your cancellation water licence application for the above-mentioned project, which was received on December 29, 2010.

The application mentions that "at the end of the program the latrine pit was backfilled and treated with lime and the greywater sump was backfilled. The land was returned to its original contours. No fuel was stored on site and all garbage was backhauled to the Nanaimo dump for disposal". However, this information is not confirmed by any photographs of dismantled site. No INAC Inspection was reportedly carried out on site.

The 2008 Annual Report indicated that "all sumps were treated with lime and backfilled to previous contour. All camp materials were removed from site". 2009/2010 Annual reports were not submitted and no other indication that further works were carried out after the 2008 program. An Abandonment and Reclamation Plan was submitted on November 05, 2010, which describes the reclamation work completed.

The Licensee is advised of its obligations to comply with all of the terms and conditions of the Licence, including Part B General Conditions (Annual Reporting-provide written confirmation that no further activities were conducted on site after 2008) and Part I Conditions Applying to Abandonment and Restoration or Temporary Closing (provide photographs of site after activities completed).
