Re: Update on the Garry Lake project

Dear Mr. Lahusen,

As you are aware, on September 25, 2008 the Honourable Chuck Strahl, then-Minister of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada referred Uravan Minerals Inc.'s (Uravan; the Proponent) "Garry Lake Project" to the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or the Board) for review under Part 5, Article 12 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement. On February 20, 2009 the NIRB issued Guidelines for the Proponent's preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Garry Lake Project.

The NIRB has previously provided clarification to Uravan in 2009 and 2010 regarding the requirements for its submission of an EIS for the Garry Lake Project on occasions in 2009 and 2010 (NIRB File No. 08EN037). On July 4, 2011 the NIRB responded to Uravan's request for guidance regarding the EIS Guidelines issued in 2009 for the Board's Review of the project, encouraging Uravan to identify specific sections/areas of the Guidelines where it believed critical data gaps may exist. The NIRB further indicated that Uravan could seek direction from the NIRB and regulatory authorities as to how its EIS should address these gaps, once identified.

To date, the NIRB has not received any further correspondence from Uravan regarding the EIS Guidelines for the project or an anticipated date for the submission of an EIS to further this Review.

To assist with planning for 2012-13 the Board requests that Uravan provide an update on its intentions to prepare and submit a Draft EIS in order to re-engage the NIRB's Review process for the Garry Lake Project. The NIRB respectfully requests that Uravan provide this written indication by **March 21, 2012**.
