Subject: Water Use Fees - George and Goose

Morning John,

Rita passed your request onto me.

I'll refer you to 9(1)(b) of the NWT Waters Act Regulations which states that for industrial, mining and milling or misc. undertakings that the annual fee is \$30 plus one of the following (depending on water consumption):

- (i) for the first 2,000m³ per day that is authorized by the licence, \$1 for each 100m³ per day
- (ii) for any quantity greater than 2,000 m³ per day but less than or equal to 4,000m³ per day that is authoized by the licence, \$1.50 for each 100m³ per day, and
- (iii) for any quantity greater than 4,000m³ per day that is authorized by the licence, \$2 for each 100m³ per day

So, if your licence was issued for industrial, mining and milling, or miscellaneous undertakings and you used less than 100m³/day, then the fee is a flat \$30.
