## PROCEDURES FOR FURNISHING A SECURITY DEPOSIT FOR A LICENCE ISSUED UNDER THE NORTHERN INLAND WATERS ACT

- The Security Deposit may be in the form of:
  - (a) A promissory note guaranteed by a chartered bank in Canada payable to the Receiver General for Canada;
  - (b) a certified cheque drawn on a chartered bank in Canada payable to the Receiver General for Canada;
  - a performance bond issued by a surety approved by the Treasury Board for the purposes of the Government Contract Regulations; or
  - (d) any combination of the securities described in paragraphs (a) to (c).

A list of surety companies approved by the Treasury Board may be obtained by phoning or writing the Administrator (see item 5 below).

- A promissory note is the more common form of deposit. However, in the event a certified cheque is forwarded as security and is deposited into the Consolidated Revenue Fund, interest will be paid at a rate of interest at 2%.
- 3. The Security Deposit is to be filed at Yellowknife within thirty (30) days of issuance of the Licence, or as prescribed in the Licence.
- 4. The Security Deposit shall cover the period commencing on the effective date of the Licence up to and including two (2) years following the expiry date of the Licence.
- 5. The Security Deposit along with the legal conditions pertaining to the deposit shall be forwarded to:

 The Security Deposit will be placed with the Security Deposit Division, Department of Supply and Services and the Administrator will advise the Licensee of such action.
