Dear Ms. Beaulieu:

The KIA would like to thank the Nunavut Water Board for the opportunity to comment on the fore-mentioned plans submitted by Dundee Precious Metals Inc.

The KIA has reviewed the Abandonment and Restoration (A&R) and Spill Plans for the Goose Lake project and we are largely satisfied with both. However, one concern we have is the practice of depositing incinerator ash in a drill sump on site, which is listed as part of progressive reclamation at Goose Lake in the A&R plan. KIA feels more details are required in the A&R plan to reassure this practice does not result in the mobilization of ash from runoff into Goose Lake.

KIA provided comments to the NWB on the George Lake A&R Plan in a letter dated January 24 and as it seems that this document has not been updated since, KIA has no further comment. KIA has no comment in regards to the George Lake spill plan.
