Re: NWB1GOO- Miramar Bathurst Resources Ltd. - Goose Lake Project Renewal

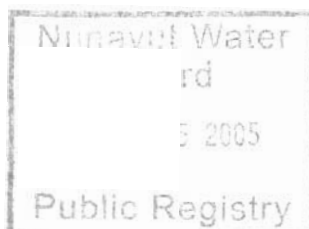
Miramar Bathurst Resources would like to work on the George and Goose Lake properties during the winter of 2005 and therefore want to answer the questions immediately so the process can continue.

The odd grab sample from the grey water sump would be done once a year to check whether there is any soap build up in the sump or if it was be degenerated by the sun and wind during the summer.

The 10 cubic metres mentioned in question seven is only the camp water and the usage is described better in Item 8 further into the application. All told the application is for 100 cubic metres of water per day as that will be necessary for the whole program.

A map is attached showing the Grey water sump as well as the Diamond Drill Cuttings sump. Nothing from either escapes into the surrounding environment

Any water decanted from the tank farm would meet all the requirements for clean water as described in the license. If the water does not pass all tests that other processed water passes it would not be released.
