Good Morning Richard,

Sabina's proposed winter road and barge landing project does include water use and waste deposit associated with the temporary camp that will be needed at the inlet and along the corridor. However, we have not applied for a new water license for any of the temporary camps we are proposing and have included them in the request to amend the Goose water license (2BEGOO1015) currently under review by the NWB.

We have taken this approach with the NWB and land use permits because the temporary camp we are proposing meets the same needs as elsewhere across the Back River project - to support resupply and exploration programs. Sabina currently holds mineral tenure at Bathurst Inlet and the proposed temporary camp (if needed) could potentially support barge resupply and future exploration programs.

Our intent is not to install camps across the area, but we do need to have the option available to us for safety and environmental reasons and will build as needed.
