Re: Application for amendment 2 water licence 2BE-GOO1015 - amendment 1

Dear Ms. Beaulieu,

Please find enclosed Sabina Gold & Silver Corp.'s application to amend the above-referenced water license for the Goose property.

Sabina sees an opportunity to continue exploration activities in the Back River area and in summary is requesting:

- An amendment to increase the daily volume of water used up to 297m³/day to be used for increased exploration activities, increased camp facilities, and other components such as water use and discharge to water (e.g. diversion/collection, water discharge and dust management).
- an amendment to include open burning of untreated wood products such as paper, cardboard and lumber when this material is either too large for the existing incinerators at Goose camps or is of a significant volume that it exceeds the capacity of the existing incinerator. This amendment to include open burning will support on-going waste management and reclamation of the camp facilities.

This request for water licence renewal and amendment is submitted with one hardcopy and one electronic copy of:

- NWB application for water license amendment form with appendices;
- Summary in three languages;
- Supplementary questionnaire for exploration/remote camps; and
- \$30.00 application fee.
