Dear Ms. Beaulieu:

The Government of Nunavut, Department of Environment (DOE) has reviewed an amendment application for the Goose Lake Project from Dundee Precious Metals Inc. (proponent).

Based on DOE's Environmental Protection Act, DOE believes that the Proponent's requests to have a daily water consumption of up to 155 cubic meters from 130 cubic meters per day, and take water for drilling operations to include the Wishbone, Lovechild, Mahna Mahna, Malley (collectively referred to as the "Wishbone Trend") and Del claim groups are reasonable.
