**Re: 2BE-GOO0510 (previously NWB2GOO0510) - Dundee Precious Metals -
Goose Lake Project - 2005 Annual Report Review**

On behalf of the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development (DIAND), I have reviewed the 2005 Annual Report, submitted by Dundee Precious Metals with respect to the Goose Lake Project. The 2005 Annual Report was reviewed with respect to NWBB2GOO0510.

The requirements for an Annual Report are laid out in Part B, Item 2 of the water License. Item 2i requires a summary report of water use and waste disposal activities. The 2005 Annual Report provides total consumptive data, however there is no information to suggest the volume of daily consumption. Although daily water consumption reporting is not a specific requirement of License 2BE-GOO0510, this information is required to ensure the daily licenced maximum water use of 100 cubic meters is upheld.

Also, the proponent should update their Spill Contingency Plan to include Mr. Peter Kusugak, (867) 975-4295 as their INAC contact.
