Thank you for your email info on the mentioned proposal.

You've asked if it was okay to have Bryant Environmental Consultants do the background development of the drawings and engineering as backup to the required water license amendmend. The KIA does not have any problems with HBJV using the 'Assessment Report on Solid Waste Disposal Site at the Boston Site' produced by Bryant Environmental. This report is to be used as a guide only for follow-up to site assessemt and recommendations that the consultant has come up with.

The KIA would not recommend using Bryant Environmental Consultants Ltd. as technical back-up to HBJV for the engineering drawings and other requirements for the amendment to the water license. In saying this, the KIA feels that as Bryant Engineering is used as technical advisor to KIA, we feel that we would be in conflict if the Regulatory Regimes, i.e. NWB and NIRB and others, asked KIA for input to the amendment. I would suggest the HBJV hire another firm to do this.
