Hello Richard,

Following a conversation with CIRNAC, where we discussed the comment raised in their June 13, 2019 correspondence, Sabina confirmed that the waste water monitoring program outlined in Sabina's Trenching Application (2BE-GOO1520) will consist of daily visual inspection for evaluation of suspended sediments (i.e. murkiness) and confirmation of gravity separation. Should efficient settling not occur, and additional mitigation measures be required, the rinse water will not be discharged to the receiving environment and instead redirected to Sabina's existing cuttings sump and excavation.

CIRNAC have been copied on this response for confirmation.
