Dear Andrea Maynes:

On November 18, 2009 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received Indicator Minerals Inc.'s "Grail Property" project proposal from Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC). The NIRB has assigned this project proposal file number 09EN070.

The project is located in the Boothia Peninsula in the Kitikmeot region and the nearest community is Taloyoak which is approximately 80 kilometers NNW. The program is proposed to take place from April 2010 to April 2015.

The project activities include:

- Helicopter supported Diamond Drilling
- Exploration Drilling
- Set up of Temporary Camp
- Mineral Exploration including: Prospecting, Mapping, Ground Geophysical Surveys
- Use of Water from Chantrey Lake and potential use for drilling purposes
- Incineration of combustible waste
- Storage of fuel at camp

- Whether the project is of a type where the potential adverse effects are highly predictable and mitigable with known technology, (please provide any recommended mitigation measures); and
- Any matter of importance to the Party related to the project proposal.
