**a. A summary report of water use and waste disposal activities;**

*All the waste generated during the drilling under this licence was transported and managed at the Agnico Eagle Meadowbank mine. The drilling on this project lasted 8 days and the drill used an average of 21.1 m<sup>3</sup>/day during that time. The table below shows the usage per day:*

*Since 2014, exploration has been managed by Agnico Eagle Mines Ltd (AEM), following an agreement with Aura Silver. AEM used its own Spill Contingency Plan during the exploration. The Spill Contingency Plan, Exploration Camp and Sites, February 2015 is attached in Appendix A.*

**d. A description of all progressive and or final reclamation work undertaken, including photographic records of site conditions before, during and after completion of operations;**

*Drill hole reclamation was completed during the drilling program. The drilling sites were inspected after the drilling to ensure that no waste was present and that the casings had been removed or cut to ground level.*

*No artesian flow occurred during this exploration project.*

**1. The Licensee shall measure and record, in cubic metres, the daily quantities of water utilized for drilling and other purposes.**

**2. The Licensee shall provide the GPS co-ordinates of all locations where sources of water are utilized for all purposes.**

**3. The Licensee shall determine the GPS co-ordinates (in degrees, minutes and seconds of latitude and longitude) of all locations where wastes associated with drilling operations are deposited.**

*All the waste generated was transported to the Agnico Eagle Meadowbank Mine and the drill cuttings were disposed of near the drilling sites.*

**4. The Licensee shall obtain representative samples of the water column below any ice where required under Part F, Item 5 and 6. Monitoring shall include but not be limited to the following:**

*No drilling on ice occurred in 2014 under this licence, the drilling was done during the month of June.*

**6. All analyses shall be performed in a laboratory accredited according to ISO/IEC Standard 17025. The accreditation shall be current and in good standing.**

*No samples were taken during this exploration program.*

**h. Any other details on water use or waste disposal requested by the Board by November 1 of the year being reported.**

*No details were requested by the Board.*
