## Good morning,

The January 20, 2011 open burning request for 2BE-HAK0915 references Part D, Item 4 of the licence as:

• The Licensee shall not open burn plastics, wood treated with preservatives, electric wire, Styrofoam, asbestos or painted wood to prevent the deposition of waste materials of incomplete combustion and/or leachate from contaminated ash residual, from impacting any surrounding waters, unless otherwise approved by the Board in writing.

When the 2BE-HAK0915 Licence Part D, Item 4 reads as:

• The Licensee shall provide to the Board documented authorization from all communities receiving wastes from the Hackett River Project prior to any backhauling of wastes to those communities.
