Resumption of operations at Hackett River & Wishbone Camp (Hackett River Project)

Dear Amanda,

This letter will serve to advise you that Glencore Canada Corporation (Glencore) will be resuming operations for the season on or about April 5, 2014 for Hackett camp (the "Hackett River project").

A maximum of 15 people will be on site. The camp will remain open for 3-4 weeks. Activities planned for the season will include maintenance and on-going camp improvements to support future programs that will build on our commitment to providing safe working conditions and minimizing impacts to the local environment.

As per the terms of various licenses, best management practices will be applied.
