I was able to get in touch with Strongbow/North Arrow's previous lands administrator as she mentioned that annual license fees are only applied during the years when the license is 'active' (not expired). She also mentioned to me that she checked with you not long ago about outstanding fees, and everything was paid and up to date for the licenses.
