RE: NOTIFICATION TO THE HAMLET OF KUGLUKTUK, KUGLUKTUK ANGONIATIT ASSOCIATION, REGULATORY AGENCIES, AND OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES REGARDING FUTURE FUELS' MINERAL EXPLORATION ACTIVITIES AT THE HORNBY BASIN PROPERTY

Dear Mr. Niptanatiak, Ms. Evaglok, the Manager of Community Economic Development Kitikmeot, and the Kugluktuk Angoniatit Association,

I am writing on behalf of Future Fuels, a mineral exploration company preparing to undertake general exploration activities at the Hornby Basin Property, located in the Kitikmeot region of Nunavut. This outreach is part of our continued effort to engage in meaningful consultation and ensure that our activities align with the expectations and guidance of local land stewards and users.

The Hornby Basin Property comprises approximately 331,767 hectares (~3,318 km²) of Crown land and 9,946 hectares (99.46 km²) of Inuit Owned Land (IOL) and is situated about 95 km southwest of Kugluktuk.

Future Fuels is committed to conducting exploration in a responsible and sustainable manner. We place a strong emphasis on environmental protection, respecting Indigenous rights, and the development of positive, collaborative relationships with the communities in which we operate.



As part of our consultation process, we would welcome the opportunity to begin a dialogue with representatives from your community. Through these conversations, we hope to:

1. Share information about our planned exploration work at the Hornby Basin Property, including our objectives, methodologies, and any anticipated environmental or community impacts.
2. Hear your perspectives, concerns, and recommendations regarding our activities and the broader regional development and integrate your feedback into our approach.
3. Explore potential avenues for community engagement, including employment and participation opportunities, particularly as we consider future phases of exploration; and
4. Establish ongoing lines of communication and feedback for the duration of our work in the region.

We recognize that consultation is a two-way process, and we are committed to listening and responding respectfully and meaningfully. Your insights are important to us as we strive to operate in a way that is transparent, respectful, and mutually beneficial.
