Dear Ms. Stritychuk:

The Nunavut Water Board acknowledges receipt on July 8, 2002 of your water licence application for Heeqou Property. Your application included the following items:

- cover letter dated July 4, 2002
- Non-technical project proposal summary in English AND Inuktitut
- application form
- supplementary questionnaire
- map
- additional information re abandonment and restoration

Based on the information received and preliminary review, indications are that you will require a water license. There is an application fee of \$30.00 required which can be forwarded to this office, payable to the Receiver General for Canada. This project is currently being screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board for their determination as to whether they require further review, or if it can be processed by the Nunavut Water Board.

I have been asked by the Board to inform you that a notice of your application is required. This notice of requirement is based on Article 13.3.14 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), which states that the Board should take "...all steps necessary by way of notice...to provide and promote public awareness [of hearings]."

Accordingly, the enclosed notice in both English and Inuinaqtun will be posted for a period of 30 days, with local establishments in Kugluktuk and Cambridge Bay.

Upon request from the public, we ask you to make available, free of charge, copies of all documents pertaining to this application. Any person who is affected by this application or

concerned with it, may submit a letter of concern, which must be submitted to the Board within the period of time shown on the public notice.
