2. The number and locations of drill sites, along with a map and their latitude and longitude. Will water be used for drilling? How will the wastewater and drill cuttings be handled?
3. The names of all water sources used and the total volume of water used per day for domestic and drilling purposes.
4. Volume of waste water to be held in sumps and the proposed dimensions of the sump.
5. It is written in the non-technical project summary: "In the second year, the programs will be somewhat similar." Explain how the project activities will be different in the second year and ensure the application reflects these activities.
6. Provide a copy of the Spill Contingency Plan and MSDS sheets.
