## Dear Ms. Chadwick:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) has completed its final review of the application submitted by Canterra Minerals Corporation (Diamondex Resources Ltd.) for the cancellation of Licence 2BE-HEE0712, issued to the Heeqou Property Project, located 220 kilometres south southeast of Kugluktuk, within the Kitikmeot Region of Nunavut.

The review, which considered the application documents, file history, interveners' submissions<sup>1</sup>, and Inspection Reports<sup>2</sup>, has determined that the application generally satisfies the conditions required for cancellation of the licence.

By copy of this correspondence, the Board is informing the Licensee and interested persons that Licensee No. 2BE-HEE0714 has been cancelled in accordance with s. 43(1) (c) (i) of *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act* (*Act*), and as directed under Board **Motion No. 2013-B1-048**.
