Newmont is requesting the official closure of Nunavut Water Board License 2BE-2HEN0508.

This license authorized water use (not to exceed 60 cubic meters a day) and waste disposal during camp operations and exploration drilling operations at the Henik Lake Project located within the Kivalliq Region, Nunavut (camp located at latitude 61"30'N, longitude 98"00'W.

The purpose of activities under this water licence was to evaluate the potential for economic concentrations of minerals within Inuit land parcels and adjacent Federal Crown Lands within NTS map sheets 65G and 65H, specifically NTS 65G9 and 65H12 and to place a temporary fuel cache at the Henik Lake airstrip (NTS 65H11; IOL Parcel AR27). Exploration activities included geological mapping, geophysical surveys (airborne and ground), rock and soil sampling, prospecting and diamond drilling. Nueltin Fly-in Lodge was used as the base camp and staging area for this exploration project. As described in the enclosed Final Report, the activities during 2006 were related to a small drill program of 298m of conventional drilling completed during the period of June – August 2006. To the best of our knowledge, no activities were conducted on site during the years of 2007, and 2008.

As noted in the attached AANDC inspection report dated July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2013 there are no signs of waste or disturbance in the claim extent, and overall very little was noted during the inspection. As there are no outstanding issues or concerns in relation to this site, Newmont requests the Nunavut Water Board to cancel Type B Water Licence 2BE-HEN0508.
