Re: Application Renewal Acknowledgement for the High Lake Project

Dear Mr. Neill:

The Nunavut Water Board acknowledges receipt on April 27, 2005 of your renewal water license application, for the High Lake Project. As per current water license issued July 31, 2003, Part G, Item 2, an addendum to the approved Spill Plan shall be submitted within 30 days of issuance of water license. To date we have not received any documents pertaining to this clause. Also as per Part H, Item 1, the licensee shall submit to the board for approval a preliminary Abandonment and Restoration Plan within 6 months of issuance of water license. To date we have not received any information from the proponent.

We undertook a preliminary review of your application and conclude that it does not contain sufficient information for the NWB to evaluate the qualitative and quantitative effects of the use of water or the deposit of waste on water. Specifically, we are asking you to provide the following; Spill Contingency Plan and Abandonment and Restoration.

Also required is a \$30.00 Water Use Fee, pursuant to the Northern Inland Waters Regulations, which became effective as of January 1, 2004. Please refer to these regulations which are on our ftp site at "nwb" / NWB Administration / NWB Waters Legislation. Currently this license requires a Water Use Fee for the period July 31, 2004 to July 31, 2005.
