**High Lake Water License 2BE-HIG0712 Amendment**

This is a request for the amendment of Part H Section 4 of Water license 2BE-HIG0712 to allow for 2 buildings located at the High Lake Camp to remain within 30 meters of the high water mark of High Lake. The two buildings house the generator from the camp as well as tools and equipment for the drillers. See attachment showing the buildings in question. The farthest building away from the high water mark is 19.3 meters and the closest being 11.9 meters. There will be no Hazardous Materials stored in any of the buildings other than the fuel source for the generator and the fuel source for heating the drillers shack. The fuel sources will be stored within a containment structure capable of storing 110% of the largest single storage capacity. An additional spill kit will be stored within each of the two buildings as well a larger spill containment kit down gradient of the two shacks and a boat capable of deploying water top spill booms. Weekly inspections of the aforementioned buildings will occur and findings documented.

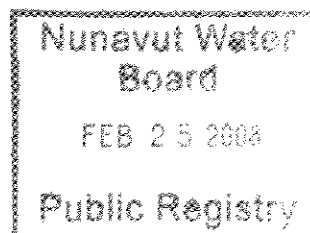
High Lake itself has shown to be void of fish by independent environmental studies conducted by Gartner Lee Limited in 2004. This corresponds to historical records of the property dating back to initial occupation of the present camp location in the 1950's.
