Most of the Camp was erected prior to the acquisition of the property and the camp has been in existence since the 1950's. The topography is very vertical and any flat lying areas are extremely limited. Moving the buildings will cause an increase in the footprint of the camp which is something we would like to avoid. Being that the closest part of the building based on available mapping information is 18 meters from the waters edge we feel that with proper fuel containment, stringent monitoring, and spill contingency planning that this risk can be mitigated to a level that is equal to having the buildings moved to a distance of at least 30 meters.
