The High Lake Camp is actually situated on a very small parcel of Crown Land, and is therefore INAC's decision, as the land owner to accept the Zinifex application to amend the existing water licence.

For Projects on IOL, The KIA does not permit the storage of fuel within 30m of the high water mark of any waterbody, and in view of that, does not support this amendment.
