Re: High Lake Project, 2005 Baseline Programs: Summary of Work Plans

Wolfden Resources Inc. (Wolfden) is a Canadian exploration and mining development company that holds the mineral rights for the High Lake property and the Ulu property. Both properties, which together form the High Lake Project, are located in the Kitikmeot Region of Nunavut and are located principally on Inuit Owned Land south of the Coronation Gulf coast (Grays Bay). Wolfden's plan is to develop the High Lake Project to exploit the base metal and gold resources at the two properties. This will entail the construction of the necessary infrastructure needed to mine, process and transport ore and concentrate within the project area. The project plan also includes the construction of a dock on the coast for the transport of metal concentrates to markets and to service the mine with supplies.

Wolfden is conducting environmental, socio-economic and engineering baseline studies for the area between Ulu and Grays Bay to support a regulatory application to secure the necessary approvals for development of the High Lake Project.

As part of the consultation process for the project, Wolfden is committed to providing information about our baseline data collection programs to governments, communities, Inuit organizations and other interested parties. In keeping with this commitment, please find enclosed the following document: *High Lake Project, 2005 Baseline Programs: Summary of Work Plans*. This document summarizes the work plans for the 2005 baseline program, focussing on required field data collection aspects.


