The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") acknowledges receipt on January 15, 2010 of your new water license application for the High Lake Project, file number 2BE-HIG0712.

- Updated SCP that includes MolyMag Camp
- Updated A&R Plan that includes MolyMag Camp
