## RE: Amendment to Water License NWB2HIG0506– Wolfden Resources High Lake Project.`

Dear Richard:

The Department of Environment (DOE) has reviewed the water license amendment application from Wolfden Resources, and has the following comments and recommendations.

## DRILLING WITHIN 30M OF WATER BODIES

It is noted that the proponent intends to conduct drilling within 30 meters of a water body. DOE suggests that fuel should be stored at a cache a minimum of 30 meters from the high water mark. A limited supply of fuel can be temporarily brought within the 30m zone to support the drill; however, there must be secondary containment system to prevent spillages.

All external pumps or motorized equipment used in the drilling operation should also have a secondary containment system.

Drill cuttings should be disposed of in a land based sump at least 30 meters from the high water mark.
