## Re: 2BE-HIG0506 - Renewal Type "B" Application - Wolfden Resources

Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) has performed a review of the Renewal Application submitted to the Nunavut Water Board by Wolfden Resources. In conducting our review INAC has made reference to 2BE-HIG0506 (expiry date Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2006) and all documents located on the Nunavut Water Board's FTP-site under the 2BE-HIG file.

Section 15, Proposed Time Schedule, of the Water Licence Application presents April 1st, 2007 as the start date and April 1st, 2012 as the completion date. Section 1, Preamble of the Abandonment and Restoration Plan (A+R Plan) states the A+R Plan is effective from January 19, 2007 to December 31, 2008. INAC recommends the proponent amend the A+R Plan to reflect length of the water licence application. Furthermore, the A+R plan may require periodic updates due to projects changes. The NWB should ensure licence condition Part I, Item 3 of 2BE-HIG0506 (expiry date Nov. 1st, 2006) is included as a condition once the licence is renewed.

Section 4, Contacts, of the Spill Contingency Plan should updated include Mr. Peter Kusugak, (867) 975-4295 as the DIAND contact within Nunavut.
