On behalf of Environment Canada (EC), I have reviewed the information submitted with the above-mentioned application. The following specialist advice has been provided pursuant to Environment Canada's mandated responsibilities under the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act*, Section 36(3) of the *Fisheries Act*, the *Migratory Birds Convention Act*, and the *Species at Risk Act*.

MMG Resources Inc. is applying for an amendment to their current water licence allowing for operation of a new temporary camp site to conduct diamond drilling on the company's MolyMag property located 55km north of Yellowknife. This will be the third amendment to the licence since renewal in 2007. This application includes water supply for 2 diamond drills, general water use in the camp and disposal of wastes.

Comments and recommendations submitted for the original application and amendments still apply and are attached. In addition, comments submitted to the Nunavut Impact Review Board on January 28<sup>th</sup>, 2010 are also attached.
