I just wanted to make you aware of MMG's intent to open its High Lake Project site on or around March 5<sup>th</sup>.

The early start will facilitate the construction of an ice air strip which will service heavy lift fixed wing aircraft and enable us to remove the remaining stockpiled fuel from site as part of our planned 2015 reclamation activities.

A small crew of not more than 10 individuals under the supervision of Peter Cullinane will occupy the camp for roughly 6 weeks in order to carry out this and other planned clean-up activities.
