Dear Mr. Roberts:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) would like to advise TMAC Resources Inc. (TMAC or Proponent) and parties of the receipt of information on December 28, 2016, related to the water license application for the Phase 2 Hope Bay Belt Project.

The Board acknowledges that the Proponent has previously requested that the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) coordinate its assessment of the Phase 2 Hope Bay Belt project proposal with the NWB's licensing process for the associated water licence application.

The Board is aware that on December 28, 2016, the NIRB issued a correspondence stating that starting from January 3, 2016 the NIRB anticipates completing the internal conformity review and providing an indication as to the acceptability of TMAC's DEIS submission by January 18, 2017.

By way of this letter, the NWB is advising that the Board will commence its internal completeness check beginning January 2017. Then the Board will issue a correspondence to seek parties review and comments as to the direction of completeness of application.
