Re: 2BE-HOP0712 Discharge from Bulk Fuel Storage Facility HOP-5

Please be advised that HBML, under Part D: Item 16 of the Hope Bay Regional Exploration Permit 2BE-HOP0712, is providing written notice to an Inspector prior to a planned discharge from the Bulk Fuel Facility HOP-5 located at Windy Camp.

Sampling undertaken at Monitoring Program Station HOP-5 July 5/10 after processing the effluent through the oil/water separator indicates that the water in the fuel storage containment area meets the effluent quality standards for discharge as specified in the licence.

The proposed volume for discharge is approx. 240m³, and the proposed location is to the tundra southeast of the berm and such that it is not within 30m of any water body. The effluent will be discharged in a manner that prevents erosion at the point of discharge and downstream.
