Re: Completion of summer exploration and initiation of November drilling program on the Hope Bay Belt

Please be advised that Miramar Hope Bay Ltd. completed the summer exploration program (drilling and surface exploration) on October 16th, 2007. Technical personnel were demobilized from Windy Camp by October 21st and Windy Camp was kept on care and maintenance by Operations personnel. Technical crews demobilized from Boston Camp on September 6 and Operations personnel maintained it as a full facility until shut down on September 11, 2007. Currently, the land based airstrip at Boston Camp will be used as a portal in and out of the Hope Bay Belt.

Windy Camp has been re-opened for the initiation of a small drill program during November. Technical personnel arrived into camp on or around November 3rd and will remain active for approximately 4-6 weeks. Drilling is expected to commence on approximately November 10, 2007.
