Dear Mr. Green:

Thank you for your interim letter report regarding Nunavut Archaeology Permit 08-013A. The Department of Culture, Language, Elders, and Youth (CLEY) has reviewed your recommendations for the Doris to Windy Lake All Weather Road and associated quarry locations (A, B, and D). While CLEY has some concerns and conditions, outlined below, CLEY has no objections to the construction of the All Weather Road proceeding as long as the procedures outline in your interim report; including Nuna's Quarry Development Plans are adhered to.

It is unclear if the proposed location for the access road to Quarry B was assessed for its archaeological potential during the 2008 field season and CLEY would like clarification regarding this matter. Should the archaeological site protection plan fail Nuna must stop its activities immediately. Failure means, for example, a stone marker is damaged before, during or immediately after a blast. Site monitoring must be conducted after the blasting has occurred. These site visits may occur in either 2008 or 2009 and a report to CLEY regarding the conditions of the sites near blasting locations must be submitted so that it can be determined if the measure implemented by Nuna were sufficient.
