Re: November 2007–Monthly Monitoring Report for Water License 2BE-HOP0712

Following is the monthly report for November 2007 as required under Water license 2BE-HOP0712.

Monitoring Program

During the month of November 2007, no water and effluent samples were collected, as part of the monitoring program. This was due to several incidences to the RBC unit and the grey water lines systems. Windy Lake was frozen during the reporting period making sampling at HOP-3 unsafe for sampling. No effluents were discharged from HOP-4, HOP-5 and HOP-6 during November.

Water usage

During the month of November 2007, Windy Camp was in operation for the whole month of November 2007. Water abstraction pumps were located at Windy Lake (HOP-1). Table 1 provides the water volume usage as required under Part J, Item 6 of the water license.
