Re: August 2012 - Monthly Monitoring Report for Water License 2BE-HOP1222

Part I Conditions Applying to Abandonment and Restoration

HBML has removed all core from the historic tundra storage locations to a permanent location on the Quarry D overburden pad and temporary storage on the Quarry D pad. Waste removal from the camp area and various locations around the Hope Bay Belt is ongoing. The debris from all of the cuttings dumps has been removed. A complete inventory of each drill site location on the Hope Bay Belt has been conducted; the information is required for planning the drill site reclamation activities for 2013 and beyond.

Part J Items 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6: Sewage Treatment Effluent, Bulk Fuel Containments, and Quarries

Windy Camp has been closed for operations since October 23, 2008; therefore the licence requirements relating to the WWTF (HOP-2 and HOP-3) are not applicable. HOP-5 (Bulk Fuel Storage – Windy Camp) was dismantled on July 2, 2012, and the area was graded and covered in coconut mat to prevent erosion as per the letter dated July 15, 2012. HOP-6 (Bulk Fuel Storage Facility – Patch Lake) was dismantled, therefore water will not need to be managed from this containment any longer. HOP-8 has not been constructed. Water did not need to be managed at HOP-7A, B or D (quarries A, B and D).

Part J Item 7: Under-Ice Drilling Samples

No under-ice samples were collected.

Part J Item 8: Water Use Volumes

Water was not extracted for domestic, dust suppression, or drilling uses this month. A portable washroom trailer has been set up to support reclamation activities in the Windy Camp area; however, there is a lack of suitable infrastructure at Windy Camp for servicing the trailer. The water used in the trailer is from Doris Lake or the Doris Camp kitchen reverse osmosis tank and waste produced is being transferred to the Doris Camp wastewater treatment plant.
