Re. Application to Amend and Renew 2BE-HRP1924, Hood River

Blue Star Gold Corp. (Blue Star), through its wholly owned subsidiary Inukshuk Exploration Inc. (Inukshuk), is continuing to explore at its Hood River project, with activities coordinated with and sometimes based out of its adjacent Ulu camp (licenced separately, 2BM-ULU2030). Blue Star has recently acquired additional mineral tenure (referred to as the Roma project area) and wishes to modify the project extents and other licencing aspects associated with 2BE-HRP1924 to allow for regional exploration of all of its tenure outside of the Ulu area. The proposed activities within the proposed area have been screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB), and the Nunavut Planning Commission has already indicated that amended activities previously screened by the NIRB and consistent with the original scope do not require further screening.

In addition, Blue Star is seeking an amendment to the licence term, to maximize administrative efficiency and align its various authorization renewal schedules more closely.

Finally, this letter authorizes Sharleen Hamm to continue to act on Blue Star's and Inukshuk's behalf in matters related to water licencing.
