Hi Assol-Hope you are doing well!

No, a NPC determination specific to the change in camp location was not issued. The original application and NIRB screening considered different camp locations within the study area so the change in camp location is not a significant modification from that already screened by the NIRB. From the project summary on the NIRB registry associated with 19EA019:

"....The Exploration area is currently delineated according to the existing Agreement with NTI, and occurs in an area immediately adjacent to the Ulu property. While the exploration area boundaries may change in the future based on prospecting results, exploration is expected to occur in the general vicinity of the existing Hood River and Ulu parcels. Related, a temporary camp is proposed, for a suitable location within the current Hood River parcel. <u>Based on exploration results, it is possible that the camp may be relocated over the life of the program, to an area proximal to drilling.</u>"

Accordingly, Blue Star is seeking to relocate its camp to a different location, proximal to planned drilling, within the original study area as considered by the NPC and screened by the NIRB.
