WPC remains in the process of acquiring the Ulu Property from Mandalay Resources and as such (once the transaction has completed) WPC will be responsible for the 2BM-ULU1520 licence.

For clarity as requested by AANDC (Courtney Cox, July 24, 2014), initially the use of one drill rig is planned using an estimated 60m³ of water per day. If a second rig is warranted, it may be moved onsite which would increase the water consumption to an estimated volume of 120m³/day. Prior to a second drill is moved onsite, WPC will request an amendment to the current licence permitting it to draw 120m³ of water per day.
