**Subject: Waste Management Plan Addendum, Appendix A. Incinerator Specifications, Operations and Maintenance SOP; Type “B” Water Licence 2BE-HRP1924, Hood River Project, Inukshuk Exploration Inc.**

Dear Peter Kuhn, Sharleen Hamm:

On August 1, 2019, the Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) acknowledged the receipt of *Appendix A. Incinerator Specifications, Operations and Maintenance SOP* as the Waste Management Plan addendum (Addendum) from Inukshuk Exploration Inc. (Inukshuk Exploration or Licensee) as per requirement of Part D, Item 11 of Water Licence No. 2BE-HRP1924 (Licence). The Addendum provides information on the incineration of waste on site.

The NWB distributed the Addendum for review by interveners with a deadline for submissions set for August 8, 2019, which was later extended to August 13, 2019 at the request of Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs (CIRNA). On August 13, 2019, CIRNA recommended that the Licensee “renew its camp waste disposal permit from the City of Yellowknife and find an approved facility for hazardous waste disposal or recycling”<sup>1</sup>. The Board reminds the Licensee of the Licence requirements set out in Part D, Items 5, 6 and 7.

By copy of this letter, the Board acknowledges that *Appendix A. Incinerator Specifications, Operations and Maintenance SOP* addresses the requirement of Part D, Item 11 of Licence 2BE-HRP1924. The Board advises the Licensee that the Addendum may be implemented with the issuance of the letter.
