Dear Lee Ann,

This letter is official notification of MMG's intent to close out the Land Use Permits on Crown Lands currently held with Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC) for both its High Lake and Izok Project sites.

Following the removal of all remaining stockpiled fuel, clean up and removal of equipment from the lay down areas, and removal of 10 additional structures from sites as part of our planned 2015 reclamation activities, the sites are now fully contained within their respective surface lease boundaries.

Annual reports accompany this letter with detail on the reclamation activities undertaken, and an inspection by AANDC and KIA inspectors conducted in July speaks favourably of the work completed.
