We have read the recommendations provided by the Water Board and compiled from ECCC and CIRNAC, and accept the suggested controls for the activity.

MMG is aware of the Regulatory Bodies preference for the removal of materials from site, and we will follow this course of action to the extent that our resources permit. All efforts will be made to salvage useable materials and store them in an orderly manner on site for possible future use.

That being said, we still anticipate a volume of non-treated wood that will be unsuitable for re-purpose and will exceed our capacity for removal for site at this time given budget constraints.
