**MMG Resources Inc Exploration Program Relocation Notification - Land Use Permit
N2024C0022 – Izok**

By way of introduction, my name is Catherine Knight, and I am the new VP Canada for MMG Resources Inc (MMG) and I have taken on the accountability for the Izok Corridor Project.

The Izok Corridor Project recommenced exploration activities in the summer of 2024 with an initial surface mapping program. This work was followed by exploration activities that began in April 2025. The first phase of activities included surface mapping, geophysics and diamond drilling on the northern portion of our High Lake Crown Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs (CIRNAC) mineral claims and Land Use Permit (LUP) N2024C0021 – High Lake. The program has been based out of Blue Star Gold Corps' Ulu camp. This phase is nearing completion, and we will be relocating to the southern portion of our CIRNAC LUP N2024C0022 mineral claims in the Izok area to commence our second phase of exploration.

An email notification was sent to CIRNAC on 20 July 2025 by our exploration contractor, Aurora Geosciences Ltd. (Aurora) Field Supervisor, John Delgaty. I wanted to take the opportunity to share MMGs exploration plan with the Nunavut Water Board to formally provide notification that our second phase of exploration activities will be conducted on our CIRNAC LUP N2024C0022 and be based out of MMGs Ham Lake (Izok) camp.

The Ham Lake camp was recommissioned in June 2025 for this program by our camp services contractor, Akokli Construction Ltd. (Akokli) who will ensure all work conducted from the camp will be operating in accordance with the CIRNAC LUP N2024C0022, Nunavut Water Board Water Licence 2BE-IZO2328 and MMGs approved Management Plans.

The relocation from Ulu camp to Ham Lake camp is expected to take place between July 28th to August 5th with drilling activities to commence August 6th and run until mid- September. It is anticipated that all drilling requirements will remain the same as phase one exploration activities.
