Subject: Twin Mining Corp – Jackson Inlet Project– Land Use Plan Conformity Review – Renewal

The Nunavut Water Board received an application for licence renewal on March 15, 2001 from Twin Mining Corp. for water use and waste disposal associated with exploratory drilling for the Jackson Inlet Project in the Qikiqtani region. This application for licence renewal is deemed a “project proposal” under the NLCA and is subject to the provisions of Article 11,12, and 13 of the NLCA.

In accordance with S.11.5.10 of the *Agreement Between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada*, this project proposal shall be reviewed by the Nunavut Planning Commission to determine conformity with an approved land use plan, before it can be processed by the Nunavut Water Board.

Please note that the project proposal was **previously reviewed** in June of 2001 when the applicant submitted their original application.

The Nunavut Water Board would appreciate receiving a copy of any correspondence that would indicate the status of the conformity check.
